Dear Parent/Guardian,

As your son/daughter nears the end of their Junior Cycle journey it is now time to focus on their future choices in education.

3rd Year students have completed their CAT tests, these tests offer guidance around strengths weakness, likes and dislikes and form the starting point for discussion and consideration with you, your son/daughter and the school around the choices available as your son/daughter moves to senior cycle.

Students have 3 options available to them after Junior Cycle:

1. Participate in the Transition Year Programme (4th Year)
2. Move directly into the Leaving Certificate Programme (5th Year)
3. Move directly into the Leaving Certificate Applied Programme (5th Year LCA)

In the coming weeks Ms Boland, Ms Fogarty and Ms Quinlisk will speak with 3rd year students about their options for September 2024. All three programmes will be outlined to students and they will be encouraged to think about their options over the coming weeks.

A parent information session will take place on 29th February at 7pm to explain your son/daughter's options further to you.

Students will need to have submitted their choice by 15th March.

We encourage you to speak with your son/daughter about their choice for next year over the coming weeks so that they can make an informed decision for next year.
